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FACILITIES AND CONDITIONS FOR THE 2017 PETER BARRATT SPECIAL NEEDS FAIR HELD AT BRAMCOTE

The Fairground will operate strictly between the hours of 11 am and 1 pm,
on Wednesday, 23rd August, 2017, food will be available until 2 pm,
so please make sure you are there in plenty of time.

The event will be exclusive to persons with additional needs, including the terminally ill, and those with special needs and/or learning difficulties, plus their parents or carers, up to a maximum of 250 special needs children and young adults. The general public will not be admitted.

Transport to and from the site for groups of children and parents or carers can be arranged. Transport needs must be applied for in good time and will be assessed individually. Please contact Gordon Cowieson by e-mail shown below well before the event, if transport is required.

All the fairground rides will be free of charge.

All the showmen ride owners will be in attendance, and they will have the final say as to which persons they feel will be safe on, and enjoy, each ride.

The showmen carry public liability insurance, via the Showmen's Guild, and the fairground site and rides will be fully compliant with Health and Safety requirements.

Plenty of helpers who will wear high-visibility tabards will be on the site to assist.

In addition, a qualified and equipped St Johns ambulance will be on site throughout the event.

Special needs toilet facilities will be provided.

REFRESHMENTS:

Each child or person with additional needs will be given a wristband on arrival, together with three vouchers, which will allow them, free of charge, one burger or one hot dog, candy floss or ice cream plus one cold drink.

Each child with additional needs will receive a teddy bear when leaving the Fair Ground, please note you will need the used voucher book which must be handed to the person giving away the bears to ensure that only children with additional needs will be eligible for one.

Whilst the immediate siblings of those with additional needs are welcome, and can go on the rides, free refreshments will not be provided for them, parents or carers, but they are of course, available to purchase.

The term sibling refers to brothers and sisters only not as has been tried in the past, cousins and friends. Any other children will not be insured whilst on the Fair during this event.

Please let me know as soon as possible if any of the children, young people or adults you are in contact with would be suitable to attend, with their parents or carers.

Please don't hesitate to contact me on the email address below at any time, for more information, your advice would also be welcome, as to run this type of event, we need all the help we can get!

Please be advised that unless you are booked in you will be **refused access** to the Fair as places are strictly limited, these will be on a first come first served basis. Entry to the fairground will be from 10:30am.
